## **la gare de Sos - Booking information for self-catering holidays**

Please read carefully and let me know if anything is not clear. When you sign the Booking Form you accept these conditions, which are designed to protect us all.

1. la gare de Sos (the station) is offered for holiday rental subject to confirmation by me, David Heath, the owner, to you the client.
2. To confirm a telephone or other reservation you should complete and sign the Booking Form and return it to me along with payment of the non-refundable deposit, 25% of the total rent for your holiday. When I have received the Booking Form and deposit I will write to/email you with formal acceptance of the booking.
3. The balance of the rent (75%) and the security deposit (see paragraph 4) must be paid at least eight weeks before the start of your holiday. If I have not received your payment by the due date I may write to you and cancel your reservation. Bookings made within eight weeks of the start of your holiday should be paid for in full at the time of booking.
4. A security deposit of €500 per week is required to cover, for example, damage to the station or its contents during your holiday. I will account to you for the deposit and will return the balance to you as soon as possible after your departure. This deposit does not limit your liability to me.
5. You are strongly recommended to arrange comprehensive travel insurance including cover for cancellation, personal belongings and public liability. If you have to cancel your holiday and you have not insured against this I will only be able to consider a refund if I can re-let the station, which may not be possible at short notice.
6. For your comfort the number of people in your party may not exceed ten without my prior written agreement.
7. Holidays run from Saturday 4 pm to Saturday 10 am unless otherwise agreed.
8. I will make sure the station is clean and tidy when you arrive; you agree to take good care of the station and its contents and to leave it clean and tidy when you leave. If you leave the station in an unacceptable condition I may charge you for any additional cleaning or repairs required and I may use your security deposit towards this.
9. I want your holiday to be as pleasant and trouble-free as possible; therefore please tell me as soon as you can if anything goes wrong, gets broken or is not as you expected or if there are any defects or breakdowns in the appliances/equipment/furniture etc; so that arrangements for repair or replacement can be made swiftly.
10. If for any reason the station is not available for your holiday I will let you know as soon as possible and shall refund all the money you have paid. I shall not be liable to you for more than the rent you have paid.
11. I hope that any problems can best be sorted out on the spot but in the event that any dispute between us cannot be resolved amicably then this contract shall be governed by English law and shall be deemed to have been made in England.
